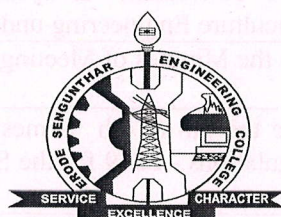

ITEM: AC:4.2	To discuss and approve the Curriculum & Syllabus (I To IV Semesters) for the UG Programme - B.Tech. Artificial Intelligence and Data Science under Regulations -2019
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- The convener presented the Curriculum & Syllabus (I To IV Semesters) for the UG Programme - B.Tech. Artificial Intelligence and Data Science (AI&DS) under Regulations -2019
- Dr.D. Manamalli Professor, Department of Instrumentation, MIT Campus pointed out that the syllabus for the AI&DS Programme upto 4th semester is focusing more on computer science courses and also she suggested to the Board Chairman-CSE to check with the BoS members whether framed curriculum and syllabus having 40% core components upto 4th semester and 60% in the higher semesters.
Dr.G.Sivakumar, Board Chairman - CSE replied that he will discuss this with BoS members and if needed suitable modification will be carried out in the curriculum and Syllabus.
- **Dr.M. Kannan**, Professor, Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering, MIT Campus,Chromepet, asked whether the entire curriculum for AI&DS programme

finalized or not with the Board Chairman

Dr.G.Sivakumar, Board Chairman - CSE replied that in the forth coming 4th BoS meeting it will be finalized with the inclusion of few industrial support placement courses.

Nirmala Devi were suggested to change the course name as “19RA404 Industrial Internet of Things” instead of “ 19RA404 Internet of Things” and in the same course Dr.S. Nirmala Devi suggested to elaborate the unit contents to know the significance of the syllabus.
