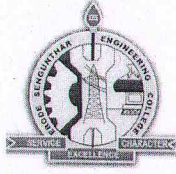

As per the recommendation of AICTE and NBA the maximum of PEO will be 6 to 8 and PO will be 5 to 7 based on the recommendation the department modify PEO and PO and to be implemented from the academic year 2023-24 onwards. Their skills should enhance with appropriate training in their chosen area of interest.</li> <li>• The students must encourage participating in conference, workshop, seminars and management games/events. This will create a activity based learning environment inside the campus.</li> <li>• Achievement of the college like NAAC certification must be shared with the students. The benefits of getting accreditation must be disseminated to the students properly.</li> <li>• Association activities should be organized and conducted by the students.
