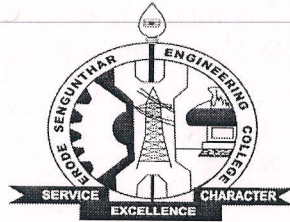

Curriculum and Syllabus either as Professional Elective or Professional Core.  
Board Chairmen - BME, replied that all the suggestion will be discussed with board of study members and will be implemented in the curriculum.

**Dr. D. Manamalli**, asked about the variations shown among the syllabus of the Department of Computer Science and Engineering and Information Technology.

Chairman – IT clarified that there are variations by giving the following syllabus with concerned to the IT.

Few of them are listed as follows:

1. Formal Languages and Automata Theory
2. Information Coding Techniques under Professional Elective
3. Advanced Computing and Communication Systems under Professional Elective , Internet of Things and Internet of Things Laboratory under Professional Core

And also she asked about whether AI techniques and Neural Network concepts like Convolution Neural Network, Recurrent Neural Networks, etc. are included in syllabus of B.Tech. Information Technology.

Chairman – IT clarified that the concepts are included under 19ITP33- Deep Learning, and also the syllabus of Professional Core subjects like 19IT601-Machine Learning and 19IT603-Big Data Analytics are designed with integrated lab.

**Er.Dr.S.Kalirajan** suggested to include the topic ‘cost management’ in the Professional Elective course “19CEX28- Construction Management”

Chairman –Civil has accepted to include “cost management” in the unit –IV of the syllabus after discussion with Board of Study members.
